

CRANE SAFETY

Crane accidents can cause serious injuries or even death

IF YOU ARE A CRANE OPERATOR, YOU HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO:

1. Notify your supervisor if crane malfunctions or has defects
2. Inspect and complete crane log books daily
3. Avoid lifting loads above workers
4. Know your right to refuse unsafe work
5. Comply with duties under *Occupational Health and Safety Act* and its regulations



IF YOU ARE A SUPERVISOR/EMPLOYER/CRANE OWNER, YOU HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO:

1. Ensure cranes are used by trained operator
2. Ensure defects are properly repaired before tower crane is used
3. Conduct tower crane load tests using required "test block"
4. Comply with duties under *Occupational Health and Safety Act* and its regulations
5. Owners: ensure record is kept of all inspections, testing, repairs, modifications and maintenance, including by previous owners
6. Owners: ensure crane inspections and maintenance is recorded in log book
