Accident Investigation Safety Training Handout

We investigate accidents to prevent similar accidents in the future.

Events that must be investigated include:

Injury - an event that results in any injury, even slight cuts

Property Damage - an event that causes damage to any building or other material, including non-company property Near Miss - an event that only by chance did not cause injury or property damage

At the scene

- Provide First Aid for any injured persons
- Eliminate or control immediate hazards
- Document accident scene to determine cause
- Interview witnesses immediately
- Collect facts about the accident
- Collect and preserve evidence

Determine

- 1. What was not normal before the accident
- 2. Where the abnormality occurred
- 3. When it was first noted
- 4. How it occurred
- 5. Sequence of events



Investigation Rules

- Use an unbiased approach during investigation
- Interview witnesses & injured • employees at the scene conduct a walkthrough of the accident
- Conduct interviews in private -• Interview one witness at a time
- Get signed statements from all involved.
- Take photos or make a sketch • of the accident scene.
- What hazards are present what unsafe acts contributed to accident
- Ensure hazardous conditions are corrected immediately.
